<b>01</b>	<b>Fencing should be provided all around the lease area. The steep cut faces of the old workings should be further demarcated, fenced and to be left as danger zone.</b>	<b>Complied</b>
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As part of demarcation and enhance safety, the project proponent has erected barbed metal wire fencing around the mining area with height of 5 ft. This will help to prevent falling of animals/human being/dumping of garbage etc. The steep cutting faces of old working quarries are demarcated and project proponent has fenced around to ensure safety and to prevent falling of humans and other living creatures. The area has left as non working area and marked as danger zone to prevent possible accidents.

<b>02</b>	<b>Overburden must be stored in the designated places and provide with protective support walls.</b>	<b>Complied</b>
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Overburden is an inevitable byproduct of building stone quarry. The overburden materials are stored within the site at designated place. This will be used to restore the exploited area in future. To prevent soil erosion, the proponent has started to plant various grass on the overburden, which can hold the soil during rainy season. To prevent erosion and sliding a retaining wall also provided. The photograph of Overburden and top soil is provided as **Plate No. 1**

<b>03</b>	<b>The old pit must be maintained as a RWH structure</b>	<b>Complied</b>
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To conserve rain water, the old pit has been maintained as a RWH structure by the project proponent.

<b>04</b>	<b>Lined catch water drains should be provided at the lower elevation on the north and south to channelize storm water. The water should be let out only after clarification/ de siltation.</b>	<b>Complied</b>
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The existing pond is situated at the lowest elevation level of project area. The constructed drain through the granite building stone for channelizing the storm water is leading in to the existing pond. The storm water from all the mining area is collecting in said pond and no water is letting out. The pond itself is working as de siltation chamber. All quarry waste is settling down at the bottom of the pond. The photograph of the pond is attached as **Plate No.2**. The project proponent is very cautious that only clarified water is letting out to the public drain

<b>05</b>	<b>The main haulage road formed in the quarry must be maintained in motorable condition. The alternative road from the church side should also be maintained in good motorable condition by the proponent.</b>	<b>Complied</b>
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The project proponent has constructed haulage road in good condition to make transportation easy in the mining area. The black or white top road can reduce emission of dust from the movements of vehicles. To achieve this, the access road of 150 meter from the entrance of project site to quarry is tarred. The alternative road from the church side is maintaining in good motorable condition by the proponent in association with Gram Panchayat. The photograph of the tarred road is attached as **Plate No.3**.

<b>06</b>	<b>The ultimate depth of quarrying should be limited to 30 m above AMSL.</b>	<b>Noted</b>
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The project proponent has given instruction to the mining mate to explore the minerals as per the submitted eco friendly plan. The depth of mining won't exceed beyond 30 meter or not below the level of the nearest stream bed, whichever is less. The exploration will be done as per the plan submitted before State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Kerala.

<b>01</b>	Rain Water Harvesting capacity should be installed as per the prevailing provisions of KMBR / KPBR, unless otherwise specified.	<b>Complied</b>
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**Compliance:**

Water is valuable natural resources, to conserve the rain water the proponent has developed two rain water harvesting pond in the project site. Rain water from entire mining area has been collecting in the existing pond which is situated at the lowest level of project area through natural channels and drainages. The water from pond is mainly used for irrigation purposes, watering of plants, wetting of roads, supply to public and for dust suppression system (mainly sprinklers system) for contain dust emission. The photograph of Rain water collection pond is provided in **Plate No. 2**

<b>02</b>	Environment Monitoring Cell (EMC) as agreed under the affidavit filed by the proponent should be formed and made functional.	<b>Complied</b>
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**Compliance:**

The project proponent has constituted Environmental Monitoring Cell (EMC). The EMC appointed Mr. Thomas P A as head of the monitoring cell. The EMC meetings of the cell convene periodically and evaluate the activities towards the stipulations of Environmental Clearance order. The details of the monitoring cell are given below

<b>03</b>	Suitable avenue trees should be planted along either side of the tarred road and open parking areas, if any, inclusive of approach road and internal roads.	<b>Complied</b>
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**Compliance:**

The project proponent planted various tree saplings and native species in the project site as avenue trees and at parking area. To reduce air and noise pollution, the project proponent has planted various avenue trees along either side of the road. There is natural vegetation including trees, shrubs and climbers to reduce pollution. The details of vegetation are given below in **Table No 2**. The photograph of avenue trees is attached as **Plate No. 4**. The purchasing bill of Plants is given in **Annexure No. 17**.

<b>04</b>	Maximum possible solar energy generation and utilization shall be ensured as an essential part of the project.	<b>Complied</b>
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**Compliance:**

The project proponent has installed solar street lights to maximum possible solar energy generation and utilization. The photograph of solar street light is provided is **Plate No.5**. The purchasing bill of solar street light is given in **Annexure No. 1**.

<b>05</b>	Sprinklers shall be installed and used in the project site to contain dust emissions.	<b>Complied</b>
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**Compliance:**

To prevent dust emission, sprinklers are installed in the project site. The project proponent is splashing water on roads using a tanker vehicle. The sprinklers are installed in and around the crusher unit. The photograph of effective utilization of sprinklers is provided at **Plate No. 6**.

<b>06</b>	Eco-restoration including the mine closure plan shall be done at the own cost of the project proponent.	<b>Noted</b>
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**Compliance:**

The eco restoration and the mine closure plan will be done at the own cost of the project proponent. The project proponent started to plant various saplings in and around the project site.

<b>07</b>	At least 10 percent out of the total excavated pit area should be retained as water storage areas and the remaining area should be reclaimed with stacked dumping and overburden and planted with indigenous plant species that are eco-friendly.	<b>Noted</b>
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**Compliance:**

The project proponent will retain 10 percent of total excavated pit as rain water storage area. The remaining area will be reclaimed with stacked dumping of overburden and top soil. As part of its eco – restoration plan, the project will plant indigenous plant species that are eco – friendly on the reclaimed area.

<b>08</b>	Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) agreed upon by the proponent should be implemented.	<b>Complied</b>
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**Compliance:**

The activities under Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) activities are executed in the sector of Drinking water supply, Education and given vehicle for the Covid–19 defense programs of the community. The details are given below in table. The Receipts are attached as **Annexure No. 16**.

<b>09</b>	The lease are shall be fenced off with barbed wires to a minimum height of 4ft around, before starting of mine.	<b>Complied</b>
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**Compliance:**

The project proponent has installed fencing around the area where lease obtained. The complete installation of barbed metal wire fencing around the mining area is with height of 4 ft. The purchase bill of fencing materials is attached as **Annexure No. 2**. The photograph of barbed metal wire fencing is provided in **Plate No.7**.

<b>10</b>	Warning alarms indicating the time of blasting (to be done at specific timings) has to be arranged as per stipulations of Explosive Department.	<b>complied</b>
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**Compliance:**

The alarm can intimate the general public and labours that the blasting is going to happen. As per the stipulation of Explosive department and State Environment Impact Assessment Authority the project proponent has installed warning alarms (Siren) in the quarry site. Siren is blown before and after blasting regularly. The blasting timings are displayed in the prominent area by way of caution board. The photograph of the warning alarm is attached **Plate No. 8**.

<b>11</b>	Control measures on noise and vibration prescribed by KSPCB should be implemented.	<b>Complied</b>
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**Compliance:**

To reduce noise level in the project site, the project proponent has implemented mitigate masseurs. The major noise generating sources from the mining activity is working machineries, drilling, blasting and plying of vehicles. The following control measures are undertaken to bringing down the noise levels:-

- Maintain proper vegetation
- Proper maintenance of machinery and equipments

- The machineries like breaker and excavator has well sound proof cabin so that the machine operators can work without stress due to the sound.
- Personal protective devices i.e., ear plugs are provided to workers working in high noise areas.
- The mining activity held in day time only.
- Noise level at quarry site is monitoring periodically.

#### ***Blast vibrations and control measures***

- ❖ Appointed mines manager
- ❖ Controlled blasting technique is adopted in this project in order to reduce blast vibrations.
- ❖ Ordinary and electric delayed detonators are using for the blasting
- ❖ The maximum charge per delay is not more than 10kg to limit the PPV values to 10mm/sec.
- ❖ Optimum delay sequence and stem to column ratio is maintaining to minimize the ground vibration intensity.

<b>12</b>	Quarrying activities should be limited to day time as per KSPCB guidelines/specific conditions.	<b>Complied</b>
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#### ***Compliance:***

To reduce the inconvenience of community, the quarrying activities are limited to day time only as per KSPCB guidelines. This will help to limit the sound pollution. The quarry working time is 7 am to 4.00 pm.

<b>13</b>	Blasting should be done in a controlled manner as specified by the regulations of explosives department or any other concerned agency.	<b>Complied</b>
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#### ***Compliance:***

The blasting is done in controlled manner by using NONEL Technology. All blasting activities are carrying out with the specified regulations of explosive department. All blasting are under careful supervision of qualified persons. The project proponent has fixed timing for blasting in the quarry i.e.10.00m to 10.30am, 1.00pm to

1.30pm and 4.00pm to 4.30pm. The sign board for the same is installed in the project site which is attached as **Plate No.9.**

<b>14</b>	A licensed person should supervise/control the blasting operations.	<b>complied</b>
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**Compliance:**

The project proponent has appointed second class manager and mining mates to supervise/control the blasting operations for the exploitation of minor minerals from the project site. **Annexure No. 3** is showing the certificate of qualified person.

<b>15</b>	Access roads to the quarry shall be tarred to contain dust emissions that may arise during transportation of materials.	<b>Complied</b>
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**Compliance:**

To contain dust emissions, the project proponent has tarred the access road of 200 meters to the quarry site. The project proponent is spraying water on the road to arrest the dust production during summer season. The photograph of concreted road is provided in **Plate No. 10.**

<b>16</b>	Overburden materials should be managed within the site and the old quarries, if any, should be reclaimed and restored.	<b>complied</b>
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**Compliance:**

The overburden and topsoil extract during the time of mining, these natural resources is staked in the project site. This is being used for plantation, haulage roads and land filling in the mining area. To prevent soil erosion grass is planted on the overburden and topsoil. The photograph of Overburden and topsoil is provided at **Pate No. 1.**

<b>17</b>	Height of the benches should not exceed 5m and width should not be less than 5m.	<b>Complied</b>
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**Compliance:**

To enhance safety and conserve environment, the project proponent extracted the minerals by creating benches. The benches will not exceed 5 meters of height and the width of the bench will have minimum of 5 meters. **Plate No.11** showing the same.

18	Mats to reduce fly rock blast to a maximum of 10 PPV should be provided.	<b>Noted</b>
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**Compliance:**

The mat is using during blasting time to prevent fly rock. The correct quantity of explosive is used under the supervision of qualified person. The project is using NONEL technology and ordinary detonator for blasting. Therefore there is no issue with fly rock in the community

19	Maximum depth of mining from general ground level at site shall not exceed 10m.	<b>Noted</b>
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**Compliance:**

The project proponent is following the approved mining plan for the exploitation of building stone. Therefore mining depth does not exceed beyond 10 meter or not below the level of the nearest stream bed, whichever is less.

20	No mining operations should be carried out at places having a slope greater than 45°.	<b>Will be complied</b>
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**Compliance:**

No mining operation is carried out with a slope greater than 45°.

21	Acoustic enclosures should be provided to reduce sound amplifications in addition to the provisions of green belt and hollow brick envelop for crushers so that the noise level is kept within prescribed standards given by CPCB/KSPCB.	<b>complied</b>
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**Compliance:**

The project proponent regularly maintains the machineries of crushing the building stones. To reduce sound amplification, the machines of crusher unit is housed with solid bricks. A green belt is also developed around the unit to reduce noise and air pollution. This helps the noise and sound level is kept within the prescribed standards. The labours in the unit are wearing ear plugs to reduce the impact of noise generating from the machines.

22	The workers on the site should be provided with the required protective equipments such as ear muffs, helmet, etc.	<b>Complied</b>
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**Compliance:**

The project proponent has provided adequate Personnel Protective Equipments (PPE) such as helmets, ear plugs, safety belts, safety shoes, gloves, etc. to the labours in working site as part of safety. The copy of bill purchased for Personal Protective Equipments is attached as **Annexure No. 4**.

23	Garland drains with clarifiers to be provided in the lower slopes around the core area to channelize storm water.	<b>Complied</b>
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**Compliance:**

The project proponent ensured that all storm water from the mining area is flowing in to the pond created at mining area. The project proponent has constructed drains with clarifiers in the lower slopes of the project area for storm water management. Photograph of drainage is attached as **Plate No. 15**.

24	The transportation of minerals should be done in covered trucks to contain dust emissions.	<b>complied</b>
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**Compliance:**

The project proponent assures the trucks are covered before it leaving the project site to arrest the dust emission while transportation of materials. A photograph of covered trucks is provided in **Plate No. 12**.

25	The proponent should plant trees at least 5 times of the loss that has occurred while clearing the land for the project.	<b>Being complied</b>
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**Compliance:**

The project proponent has been planting various saplings in the project area as a compensation of loss of trees while clearing the land for mining. Tree plantation is a continuous programme.

26	Disposal of spent oil from diesel engines should be as specified under relevant Rules/Regulations.	<b>Complied</b>
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**Compliance:**

The project proponent is using the used oil as lubricant for shutters and other equipments. The excess have been sold to agencies approved by Pollution Control board.

27	Explosives should be stored in magazines in isolated place specified and approved by the explosives department.	<b>Complied</b>
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**Compliance:**

As per the stipulation of competent authority, the project proponent has storing the explosives in magazine. The magazine was situated in an isolated place specified and approved by the explosives department. The photograph of magazine housed in solid bricks is attached as **Plate No. 13**.

28	A minimum buffer distance of 100m meter from the boundary of the quarry to the nearest dwelling unit or other structures, not being any facility for mining shall be provided.	<b>complied</b>
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**Compliance:**

To prevent possible fly rock and vibration to nearby houses, the norms of Kerala State Pollution Control Board regarding the distance criteria of residences,

roads, rivers and worship places is adhered by the project. The project has left 122 meter distance to the nearest house from the boundary of mining area.

<b>29</b>	200 m buffer distance should be maintained from forest boundaries.	<b>Noted</b>
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**Compliance:**

There is no forest near to the project site.

<b>30</b>	Consent from Kerala Pollution Control Board under Water and Air Act(s) should have been obtained before initiating activity.	<b>Complied</b>
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**Compliance:**

The Project proponent has obtained “*Consent to Operate*” (Renewal) from Kerala State Pollution Control Board. The copy of consent is provided in **Annexure No.5**.

<b>31</b>	All other statutory clearances should have been obtained, as applicable, by project proponents from the respective competent authorities including that for blasting and storage of explosives.	<b>Complied</b>
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**Compliance:**

All statutory clearances, approvals, licenses are obtained from concerned authorities. All conditions stipulated in such approvals are strictly followed.
